Major depressive disorder is the 2nd leading cause of years lived with disability in the United States, and persistent depressive disorder is the 19th leading cause (US Burden of Disease Collaborators). Psychotherapy and medication comprise the backbone of depressive disorders treatment, however, despite the availability of effective treatment, only 40% of patients with a depressive disorder receive minimally adequate treatment.
